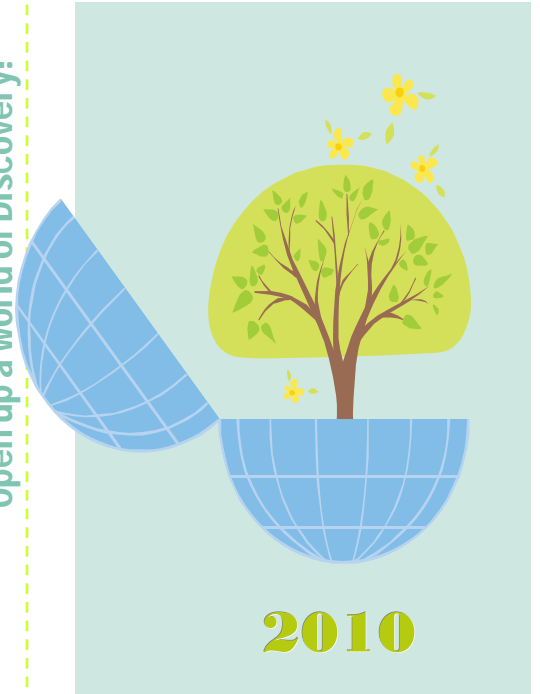

Environmental Programs

Jammin' with Junk– 60 min., Pre K– 5th grade. Take a little trash, a little time and some imagination and we can make a band! This great discovery time teaches students how to REUSE trash and make something fun and musical!

The Basics of Recycling– 30-45 min., Pre K– Adult. Learn the basics of recycling! What can we recycle? How can we recycle it? Where can we recycle it? And why should we recycle it?

Story Time– Pre-K-3rd grade. We would love to come read a story to the group! We have all kinds of environmental and recycling books to choose from!

Litter: Pick It Up, Don't Pass It Up– 60 min., K– 6th grade. What is litter? Where does it come from? What can you do about it? Find out with this interactive litter prevention program. Weather permitting, this will include a litter clean up.

Pop Bottle Science– 45-60 min., 3rd-8th grade. Reinforce scientific concepts like gravity, air, physical reaction, density, etc. in a fantastically fun and exciting way all while REUSING pop bottles! **WARNING:** portions of this project will need to be done outdoors due to a high potential for a big mess!

How Do They Do That– 45 min. What happens to the “stuff” we put in our recycling bin? It can find new life as lots of fun and useful things. This program also explains the difference between making things from natural resources and recycling. Lots of samples of recycled content items!

Enviro-Survivor– 4 hours, 5th grade-Adult. Students form tribes and execute mental and physical challenges related to care of their paradise island.

Gifts From the Earth to the Earth– Time varies, K-6th grade. Mother nature recycles things like leaves, twigs, grass and other organic materials all by herself. These trash to treasure crafts are special. We take items found in nature and create things that can go back to nature to be recycled when we are through.

Trash to Treasure Craft– Time varies, K-6th grade. Lets take a little trash and a little time and see what we can create!

Trash Bingo– 1st-5th grade. A little game that can be added to The Basics of Recycling.

Trash Olympics– time varies. Get those kiddos moving! Children will form 2 teams to compete against each other in the Trash Olympics! Obstacles may include the following: trash can relay, bottle bowling, waste no water relay, newspaper relay, putt for points and the aluminum can tower.
