

Snowman Goody Holder

Materials:

- Rinsed and dried two liter bottle
- 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch pom poms
- Black and orange foamies
- Black electrical tape
- 1 plastic grocery sack
- Decorative cellophane or tissue paper
- Hot glue
- A hole punch
- Brads



Directions:

1. Cut the top off of the two liter bottle (right above the top of the label). You will not need the top of the bottle so you can either "reuse" or "recycle" it.
2. Take the label off of the bottle. Sometimes it helps to soak the bottle in warm, soapy water for a while to loosen the glue.
3. Next, cut a 1 inch slit in the top of the bottle as shown below.
4. Then, turn your scissors parallel to the top of the bottle and cut out a one inch strip from the slit you just created. This strip will become our handle.
5. Because the strip may have jagged edges from cutting it, you will need to wrap the handle with black electrical tape.
6. Next, crinkle up your grocery sack, dab it in some white paint, and "rag paint" the entire bottle.
7. Once the white paint is dry, dab some pink paint on your grocery sack and paint some rosy cheeks on your snowman.

8. While that is drying, you can cut out a nose shape and some coal shapes for eyes and mouth pieces.
9. Once those are cut out, you can glue them onto your snowman face with some Elmer's or foamy glue.
10. Now it's time to work on the earmuffs.
Using a hole punch, line up where you think the ears ought to be and punch a hole on each side of the bottle about a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch down.
11. Now punch holes in the handle or strap about a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from each end.
12. Line up the holes of the bottle with the holes of the handle and secure it with a brad.
13. Hot glue the pom poms over the brads on the handle being careful to not glue the handle (you still want it to be able to move).
14. Now for the decorating! You can use whatever you want to line the inside of the goody holder.
