PROGRAMS

The most important service the District provides to the residents and organizations of this community is its role as a clearinghouse of information related to the recycling and proper disposal of solid waste. Daily, District staff members field phone, email and other inquiries from residents and businesses about recycling and disposal options.

Additionally, the District provides a number of waste management services to ensure residents have effective and practical ways to recycle valuable materials like paper, metals, plastics and wood waste — keeping those items from landfills and incinerators. The District’s household hazardous waste programs give Hendricks County households a way to properly dispose of materials that threaten our soil, air and water if not handled properly.



TOX-AWAY DAYS

Each year the District offers multiple Tox-Away Days to Hendricks County households. The events allow residents to properly dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW) free of charge. These types of materials should not be poured down a drain or sent to the landfill for disposal, but simply storing them in a garage, shed or basement indefinitely is dangerous and impractical. Regulations prohibit businesses from utilizing the events.

TOX-AWAY DAYS

Dispose Responsibly.

Latex paint should not be brought to a Tox-Away Day for disposal. Instead, mix an absorbent material (cat litter, oil drying product, sawdust, etc.) with the paint and allow it to harden. Once solidified, it is safe for disposal with normal household trash; lids should be left off of paint cans so trash haulers can recognize that the paint has been hardened. Document shredding is not offered at the Tox-Away Days events. Heavy trash items such as mattresses, box springs, furniture, carpeting, scrap metal, etc. are not accepted at Tox-Away Days. Recycling and disposal options for some of these items are included in the A-Z Guide beginning on page 8.



YARD WASTE RECYCLING CENTERS

Another service the District offers to Hendricks County households is the ability to recycle brush, grass clippings, leaves, Christmas trees and other organic matter at two Yard Waste Recycling Centers. The Centers, located in Brownsburg and Plainfield, are open three days each week from April through November, but are closed for major holidays.

Residents are charged a fee based on the amount of material being recycled. Business waste is not accepted at the centers. The fees help the District offset the cost of providing the Centers and are subject to change:

YARD WASTE RECYCLING CENTER PRICING GUIDELINES

Final pricing is determined by on-site Yard Waste Recycling Center attendant

Bundles Of Twigs/Branches - 25¢ each and up depending on size

up to 32 gallons: \$1.00 each

45 to 50 gallons: \$2.00 each

96 gallon or more: \$3.50 each

Trucks And/Or Trailers

6' capacity: \$6.00 per load

7' capacity: \$7.00 per load

8' capacity: \$9.00 per load

12' capacity: \$18.00 per load

14' capacity: \$22.00 per load

Leaves, grass clippings and organic wood waste material is to be left at the Yard Waste Recycling Centers. Sod, soil, building materials and plastic bags are not accepted. Users are required to unload all materials themselves. Firewood may be left at the Centers free-of-charge for others to use.

Both of the Yard Waste Recycling Centers are the result of partnerships with the towns of Brownsburg and Plainfield which provide the property on which each site is located. The towns also help with material management at the Centers.



RECYCLING DROP-OFF CENTERS

The District provides four Recycling Drop-off Centers located in Coatesville, Lizton, North Salem and Stilesville. These centers provide 24-hour recycling options for those residents that live in the portion of Hendricks County where curbside recycling is not available through the private sector recycling companies.

Users of the Recycling Drop-off Centers are asked to abide by the rules posted at the locations and not place materials other than those listed in the recycling bins. Additionally, material should not be placed on the ground outside of the recycling bins.

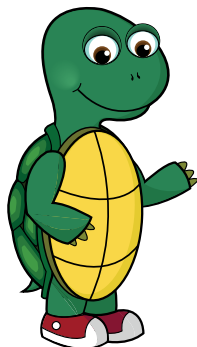

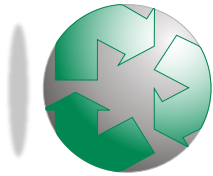
